With the power of GPT-4, an advanced AI model, Copilot enables you to:

- Quickly summarize long PDFs and articles
- Effortlessly craft professional and customer-ready content
- Create stunning images for social media, articles, emails, and more

Using non-approved AI web services can expose our company's data to the public. So always use Copilot for AI chat to help keep our company data safe with built-in commercial data protection from Microsoft.

Copilot – a new way to search

Get answers, not links

We're used to searching the internet with keywords and getting pages of links. Now, we can chat in **conversational language** to get detailed, customized answers from the internet:

We can ask for:



We can get answers that connect the dots across data points. We can get new answers that haven't been written before. This is why AI chat is often referred to as "generative AI"—it produces answers instead of links.

Chat is the new way to "internet." Simply put, Al-powered chat gives you custom answers.

- Navigate to <u>copilot.microsoft.com</u> on your preferred browser on your device. Copilot is compatible with Microsoft Edge, Google Chrome, Firefox and Safari.
- Click the Sign In button in the top-right corner of the page. Use your UBalt NetID credentials (the same for MyUBalt and Canvas) to sign in.

You will know you are successfully signed in with your work account when you see Protected tag next to your credentials in the top right corner of your screen.

What is a "prompt?"



Get started by entering your question in the text box

A **prompt** is the question or instruction you enter in the text box. This is what Copilot will respond to.

Use natural language. Don't feel like you need to break your idea or question down into keywords.

Classic search is about keywords to get a list of sources. Chat is about using detailed questions or statements to generate a custom response for you.

Enter your first prompt in the text box at the bottom of your screen.

What makes an effective prompt?



But there are no 'wrong' prompts because **natural**, **conversational language is welcome**. Experiment away!

How to chat in 3 steps



1. Enter your prompt

Enter your detailed prompt in the text box at the bottom. The box expands as you go, so you can write in sentences and paste in lots of content from a webpage, PDF, or document.

Copilot is transparent about the sources of its information. See these sources listed underneath the answer.

Vet these sources and validate your answers.





You can ask follow-up questions as you would in a conversation. You can refine the answer too.

For example, try "Write a shorter answer" or "Give me more detail." You can also select suggested prompts.



When to chat

When your day looks like this	Try this	
You searched and found some great articles, and you want to quickly make sense of them		"Summarize this content"
You collected ideas from different web pages and you're ready to write them up as an email or report		"Write an email based on these bullet points"
You can't find stock images that match your presentation, or your document has no images		"Create an image like this"
You pulled up blog posts and videos to learn something new, but you learn best by asking questions	•••	"Explain this" Or "How come"
You've got multiple articles with different perspectives on a topic, so you still can't make a decision	(+)	"Compare this option and another option in a table" or "Give me the pros and cons of"
